

(Transcript of interrogation of Alfred Jodl, 30 August 1945, page 2.)

Q. Well, in August 1939, you transferred from Vienna to Berlin?

A. Yes.. I went from Vienna and Brunn to Berlin in August 1939.

Q. And there you became a member of the OKW?

A. The telegram I had received to this effect was an indication to me that some very important matters were being taken up, because for the case of war I had been designated as a member of the Supreme Staff of the Chief of Staff of the OKW -- the Chief of Staff within the OKW, since 1939, and that official title is: "Der Chef des Wehrmachts-fuehrungstabes in Oberkommando der Wehrmacht."
