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Problem Poland.

For the time being the Fuehrer does not intend to solve the Polish question. However, it should now be worked on. A solution in the near future would have to be based on especially favorable political conditions. In that case Poland shall be knocked down so completely that it need not be taken into account as a political factor for the next decades. The Fuehrer has in mind^{as} such a solution ^a border line advanced from the Eastern border of East Prussia to the Eastern tip of Upper Silesia. Evacuation and resettlement are questions that remain open. The Fuehrer does not want to go into the Ukraine. Possibly one could establish a Ukrainian State. But these questions also remain open.
