There was a provision in the plans for 1938 that in case of any trouble between Poland and Lithuania, the intention existed to occupy Memel. (4) Witness informed of this intention, by Keitel. "Q. Is it not a fact that it was the intention of the Fuehrer not to put into effect any of the several plans "Green" that were drawn up unless he was sure that France would not interfere on the side of Czechoslovakia? A. We were assured that in no case would he execute his plans as long as there was a danger that another big power would intervene". (5)
