Salzburg, August 23, 1945

My dear Doctor:

With cordial thanks I acknowledge receipt of your esteemed letter dated the Seventh of this month, which unfortunately did not reach me until my return from Carinthia on August 21.

My cordial greetings to the Doctor now in liberty. During your long term of imprisonment I have thought of you and your heavy lot many a time. Now I join with you in thanks to Our Lord and Master for your liberation and rescue.

I regret that your secretary, Miss Anni, did not find me in Salzburg. The more so, since I looked forward eagerly to a full account. I would be very pleased if you could come to Salzburg. I have therefore enclosed an invitation for a conference with me, which I trust will facilitate obtaining a travel permit to this place.

Carinthia has a new Prince Archbishop; I stay therefore more at home. An exchange of thoughts concerning pending questions would be very desirable to me.
