Interrogation of Karl HABERSTOCK

HABERSTOCK was interrogated principally with regard to his art collecting activities on behalf of GOERING and HITLER. He stated that GOERING purchased ten pictures from him and that he acted as an agent for GOERING in the acquisition of another picture. He further stated that a number of items had been purchased from him by HITLER for the Linz art museum.

All of the detailed information regarding these art objects had been furnished previously by HABERSTOCK to representatives of the Art Looting Section of OSS and a long report thereon was written by Lt. Rousseau.
