Norway Appoints Prosecutor for German War Criminals

NED, August 31: Public Prosecutor Sven Arntzen told MONSIEUR that Major Harald Sund has been appointed prosecutor for the cases of the German war criminals in Norway. Until September 1, Major Sund will be attached to the Allied High Command. According to Arntzen, the number of German war criminals to be indicted for major crimes is about 700."

FINLAND

Finnish cabinet may resign if War Guilt Bill not Passed

BRASSLAW LEE RADIO, August 31: "The Finnish Government probably intends to resign or to dissolve the Diet if its War Guilty bill is not accepted. Under such a threat, the Government's proposal will probably be passed by the Parliament with the qualification that the responsibility will not be limited to the members of the preceding Governments."
