MEMORANDUM FOR THE BOARD OF REVIEW

SUBJECT : Trial brief on Hans Frank

1. Submitted herewith are four copies of a trial brief on Hans Frank and one copy of a folder containing translations (where available), staff evidence analyses (where translations not available), or explanatory inserts of documents or evidentiary material relied upon in the brief. Staff evidence analyses have been included because of the small number of translations available.
