Frick relates his early government service and his first contacts with Hitler and the NSDAP while he was Police referendar in Political Division in Munich 1919 - 21 (pp 1 - 9).

Frick's duties 1919 - 21 included prosecution of all the crimes committed by the Communists during the periode of the Bavarian Communist Republic. Thousands were prosecuted. (p.5).

Frick relates details of the Putsch in November 1923 and his connection with same, he being the head of the Criminal Police in Munich at the time. Explained his arrest and conviction for not having taken sufficiently energetic measures as a police official (p.25). Frick states that he had been selected by the organizers of the Putsch to be President of the Police in the new government (p.19). (All the foregoing pp 9 - 25).
