

London, March 10, 1938 - Memorandum of Ribbentrop re-
garding conversation of Halifax and Sir Horace Wilson.

1. Present British Government does not want war.
2. Chamberlain must achieve success in that direction or fall.

3. What will England do if Austrian question not solved
peaceably? England will not risk anything on her own account. In
