The interrogation deals chiefly with the various positions which witness occupied. He was editor of the Voelkischer Beobachter from 1923 until 1934; thereafter he had less connection with the paper, but it carried his name as publisher until the end (1-3). He was head of the Foreign Office in the Party, ideological leader of the Party, Reichsminister for Occupied Territories in the East, and a member of the Reichstag (4-5). In addition, he had special missions, such as the Einsatzstab Rosenberg, which had custody of cultural objects (5-6). Functions of the Foreign Political Office of the Party (6-8).
