Interrogation of LITZENBERG, Willy

Witness executed affidavit referred to in interrogation summary of 7 November 1945, III.

He requested an opportunity to talk with someone in German, off the record, and alone, concerning some questions that have been bothering him. Arrangements are being made for such an interview.

Litzenberg was interrogated by Mr. Jaari^{in German}. Nothing productive resulted, except Litzenberg's offer of co-operation in tracing down fugitive members of RSHA. Furthermore, Litzenberg says he is willing to pick out from a list of members of RSHA the persons he considers responsible for various crimes. In each case he would write down the reasons for his opinion. Litzenberg again stressed that Fumy and Duchstein could be the very best sources for information.

The affidavit by the witness was turned over to Lt. Harris of Section VI.
