1. MOTOR TRANSPORTATION: Effective this date there will be available for personnel working after hours (from 1900 on) a fleet of cars to provide transportation between the Court House, the Grand Hotel and/or other billets. Requests for transportation may be made in person at the Motor Pool, or by calling Ext. 60003. This service will also be available all day Sunday.
2. REPRODUCTION FACILITIES: Personnel will please note that the standard sizes of mimeograph paper used by the Reproduction Division are as follows: Letter size - 8 x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " , and Legal size - 8 x 13". Those desiring work done on any other size of paper will bring their own paper, or inquire at the Reproduction Section, Room 28, if such paper is available.

10. TYPEWRITERS: There is at the present moment an urgent need for standard typewriters for use in the preparation of trial documents, etc. Should anyone have a typewriter which is used only intermittently, or be in a position to operate satisfactorily with a portable typewriter in exchange for his standard machine, it will be appreciated if this information is brought to the attention of Captain Paulson of the Administrative Division (Ext. 61181).
11. SPECIAL AIR LIFTS for freight or numerous passengers can be obtained by the Transportation Section of the Administrative Division from USFET, as they have been in the past. However, such requests should be expressed in writing, specifying from where they are going, to what place, the date, the preferred time, the amount of freight or the number of passengers, and these requests should be signed by the chief of the division. The requests must be filed with the Transportation Section of the Administrative Division, Room 182, at least two days before the time of departure. It must be understood that, because of the shortage of equipment and personnel, changes will be considered as new requests and honored only forty-eight hours after they have been requested.
