1. WATCHES, LIGHTERS, ETC., AT THE PX: A limited number of watches, lighters, mechanical pencils and electric razors are expected by the PX in a few days. In order to give a fair chance to everyone now on duty in the Court House, all lists of names left with Captain Vonetes in the past will be disregarded and everyone who is interested in these items will please sign again at the PX in Room 70. You must sign between now and Thursday evening, 15 Nov. The names of the winners will be drawn by lots on Friday morning, 16 November and announced in this Information Bulletin the afternoon of the 16th. Persons thus entitled to a purchase will buy the item on the morning of Saturday, 17 November.

2. ATTENTION: ALL AMERICAN MILITARY PERSONNEL: The Third Army has made available for American military personnel only a limited number of gift items. These gift items will be for sale at the PX, Room 70, tomorrow, Thursday, 15 November. It is stressed that only officers, WACS, nurses, and enlisted men are eligible. Civilians, even if they wear the U. S. Army uniform, will not be eligible.

3. BOOKS SOUGHT: It is requested that anyone now in possession of several copies of the "Organization Book of the NSDAP", translated into English, should immediately send or bring them to the Justice's Office. Anyone knowing of their whereabouts should contact the Justice's Office.

4. ELECTRICIAN ON DUTY: There is an electrician on duty every evening until 2200 hours. His telephone is Ext. 61010; please speak to the officer or non-commissioned officer at this Ext. or on 61059. For service between 0900 to 1800, please call Ext. 61015.

5. BULOW STRASSE BUS LINE: Announcement is made of bus service to and from Bulow Strasse and the Court House. Tentatively, the bus leaves Bulow Strasse for the Court House via the Grand Hotel at 0800, 0825 and 1830. There is a bus from the Court House to Bulow Strasse at 1740, and from the Grand Hotel to Bulow Strasse at 2000 hours.

6. ON BUSES AND SCHEDULES: All buses leave from No. 1 Gate at the Court House. Buses leave on time, and schedules are available. Please don't try to get on the bus after it is in motion. An accident took place recently when a party stopped a bus as it left the Court House.

In the evening 19 buses leave the Court House in 40 minutes. Buses are allotted on the amount of personnel living at various billets. Please ride the bus that has your final billet destination on it, otherwise you transfer unnecessarily at the Grand Hotel, and furthermore, you cut some other party from a seat on his bus.

ON BUSES AND SCHEDULES (cont'd):

Recently it has come to the attention of the Motor Pool that there have been demands made by the passengers of the bus drivers, such as wanting the bus drivers to leave earlier or later, or to go to a different stop than the regular one. Bus drivers are not authorized to make any deviations from the schedules whatsoever. If you have any suggestions to make regarding bus service, please call the bus officer at the Court House Motor Pool on Ext. 60003.

7. SUNDAY TRIPS: The Sunday trips will be scheduled as follows. You are reminded that accommodations are allotted on the basis of "first come first served", and therefore you should sign up immediately in Room 115.

- a) MUNICH AND DACHAU: Leaving the Grand Hotel at 0930, returning at approximately 2000 or 2100 hours. You will travel in a bus. There will be a charge of 2½ RM's per person for K rations. There are accommodations for 19 persons.
- b) ROTHENBURG-OB-DER-TAUBER: This is a popular scenic trip to one of the oldest walled cities. There is a little shop here in the town square where guide books may be purchased, prints and cards. If you have a camera, bring it along, as there are many lovely views which you will undoubtedly wish to capture. You may visit one of the two old churches here which are quite interesting, and if there is sufficient time, wander along the edge of a spacious park. TIME OF DEPARTURE from the Grand Hotel is 1300. Accommodations for 26 persons.
- c) SELECTED TRIPS IN VICINITY OF NURNBERG: There are three C&R cars available for selected trips in the vicinity of Nurnberg. Accommodations for 12 persons.

8. MESSENGER SERVICE: In order to make more soldiers available for important duties, the messenger service of the Court House had to be revised. It is felt that a new organization will provide as good, if not better service, as in the past, providing the following two precautions are carefully observed by everyone sending a message to another person in this building:

- a) Clearly indicate on every document the name of the addressee. In certain cases, it may be advisable to clip a little "chit" with the name properly printed, and, b) clearly indicate the room number of your addressee. Measures are being taken to insure coverage of every office every hour or so, which will be improved as both messengers and customers become accustomed to the new service. In case of an urgent message, or of an extraordinarily bulky document, just call Ext. 61009 and a special messenger will be dispatched immediately.

9. IMT STICKERS FOR AUTOMOBILES: All persons having automobiles without an IMT sticker attached to the windshield, must apply one thereto by 0700 on 16 November. They may be obtained in the Security Office, Room 10.
