1. IMMUNIZATION: All OCC personnel who have not received an injection of influenza vaccine will do so this week up through Friday in Room 24. Please bring your immunization card with you to the Dispensary when you report for your influenza vaccine.

3. OBITUARY: We regret to announce that Mr. Frank P. Thenaud of the Translating Division passed away on 22 November 1945 at the 116th General Hospital after a short illness. We wish to extend our sympathy to his wife of Cincinnati, Ohio, to his family of Paris, France, to his cousin, Mr. Lauga, recently arrived in Nurnberg, and to all those of his Division who, like his Chief, Colonel Dostert, had learned to understand and admire him.

4. ELECTRIC CURRENT IN NURNBERG: There will be no electricity on the City system on the following days: for Direct Current - Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 0700 to 1100; and for AC or Alternating Current - Tuesdays from 0800 to 1200, Wednesdays from 1200 to 1600, Fridays from 0800 to 1200, and on Saturdays from 1200 to 1600. The reason for this is low level water in the Munich area and the Bavarian Alps which supply most of the power to the Nurnberg area.

5. ILLNESS: Because of the increasing number of personnel sick in quarters, it is requested that all personnel requiring medical attention at home will please notify the Dispensary at the Court House by 1000 A.M. Otherwise, except in emergency cases, the Medical Department may not be able to make necessary arrangements for examinations, medicines, or transfer to the hospital when necessary. Persons who are at all able to report to the Dispensary in person are urged to do so, rather than to call for a house visit. Should the Medical Department advise a patient to go to the hospital, it is compulsory that he do so.

6. SUNDAY TRIPS: Anyone who signed for the Munich Trip on Wednesday, 21 November in Room 115 must sign again, as the Trip List has been mislaid. All personnel are reminded that each individual must sign in person, in accordance with the policy of "first come first served".
